**\*\*Musical Freestyles:** Adequate sound system provided. Music on CD or cassette only, must be delivered to the announcer at least 3 hours before the start of the class. **Mail test sheet from the highest test, 58% or higher(60% for Championships) in a USEF show with your entry.**

**\*\*\*Team Competition - 4 Members per Team; no more than one Professional per team: one designated class per Team Member; rides must be designated on entry; one ride per Member. Team Member Fee \$10. Freestyles and Pas de Deux CANNOT be used for Team Competition. **Team Mounted Awards Ceremony on Sunday during the Lunch Break, riders are to be properly attired and mounted.****

**2. ENTRY FEES: Class fees are per class. Each competition must be on a separate entry form and must pay separate fees for each competition (exception:stabling is paid ONCE for the weekend.)** Training - Fourth \$50; FEI \$75; plus respective fees below. Office Fee (horse/rider) \$35; GAIG/USDF Qualifying: \$10\*; Team Competition \$10 per horse/rider; Drug/USEF Fee per horse \$15;USEF Non-Member Fee \$20.00; USDF Non Member Fee \$20; Any changes of time or rider within a class-per change \$25; Late Entry fee - accepted at management's discretion - plus regular class fee per entry \$50; Non Competing horse (schooling) per horse \$50; Program notation - horse(s) for sale \$35. Returned Check/Declined Credit Card Fee: \$50, plus bank fee. Equine Nanny Services \$10 per horse per night. **NOTE: Management reserves the right to split, cancel, or change the day of classes to balance unusual amounts of entries, excessive scratches or due to extenuating circumstances. All riders/owners/handlers must restrict horse use to WDC leased arenas, warm-ups and barn areas as designated ONLY. \*Credit Cards Welcome: Visa, Mastercard,AMEX-must include name, billing address, card number, expiration date and 3 or 4 digit security code( on back of card) on entry form. - 3. STABLING & TACK FEES – Limited number Permanent stalls with doors wood with metal fram construction 10 X 10, \$95 per stall (Friday 12 noon through Sunday 6pm). PLUS A SEPARATE STALL CLEANING DEPOSIT CHECK FOR \$25 (The \$25 check will NOT be deposited if stall is left stripped per Jim Brandon rules). Initial bedding NOT provided but may be pre-purchased for \$7.00 per bag. ABSOLUTELY NO HORSES will be accepted for stabling OR schooling until 12noon the day before the competition begins-early arrivals will be subject to a \$50 penalty per horse--Move in /schooling hours are from 12pm- 5:30pm. (All bedding is the responsibility of the owner, including acts of God/ weather)**
- 4. AWARDS – Divisions (JR/YR, AA, Open) may run concurrently as one class. Ribbons for six places. Trophy for first place. All ties will be broken.**
- 5. TIMES: ALL RIDE TIMES ARE TO BE CONSIDERED TENTATIVE ( Check online at [www.wellingtonclassiddressage.com](http://www.wellingtonclassiddressage.com))**  
Times will be posted the day before the show after 1:00 p.m. at the show grounds and mailed to your winter address about 1 week before the show & also available on show's website. **Times are tentative and it is the rider's responsibility to know their final ride times, as times may change due to scratches. Consult posted times each day on grounds for up-to-date-times!!!** \*\*EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH" (GR1401.9)
