**Musical Freestyles: Adequate sound system provided. Music on CD or cassette only, must be delivered to the announcer at least 3 hours before the start of the class. Mail test sheet from the highest test, 60% or higher in a USEF show with your entry.

2. AWARDS

Ribbons for six places. Trophy for first place. All prize Money Paid to Owner of Horse.

3. ENTRIES (class fees are per class)

Introductory - Fourth \$65; FEI \$85; GAIG/USDF Qualifying: \$10*; Office Fee (horse/rider) \$35; Drug/USEF Fee per horse \$15;USEF Non Member Fee \$30.00; USDF Non Member fee \$25; Any changes of time or rider within a class-per change \$35; Late Entry fee-accepted at management's discretion-plus regular class fee per entry \$50; Non Competing horse (schooling) per horse \$65; Program notation - horse(s) for sale \$35. Returned Check/Declined Credit Card Fee: \$50, plus bank fee. Haul-in/Walk-in fee is \$50 per day if not stabling. **NOTE: Management reserves the right to split, cancel, or change the day of classes to balance unusual amounts of entries, excessive scratches or due to extenuating circumstances. All riders/owners/handlers must restrict horse use to GCDA leased arenas, warm-ups and barn areas as designated ONLY. *Credit Cards Welcome: Visa, Mastercard,AMEX-must include name, billing address, card number, expiration date and 3 or 4 digit security code(on back of card) on entry form.**
NO REFUNDS, INCLUDING STABLING, FOR ANY REASON AFTER THE CLOSING DATE; including USEF art. GR311.

4. TIMES ALL RIDE TIMES ARE TO BE CONSIDERED TENTATIVE (www.wellingtonclassicdressage.com

or www.dressagedaily.com) Times will be posted the day before the show at the show grounds and mailed or e-mailed to your contact information on file about 1 week before the show & also available on WCD website. **Times are tentative and it is the rider's responsibility to know their final ride times, as times may have changed from preliminary schedule-- Consult posted times each day on grounds for up-to-date-times!!!**

5. STABLING & WALK-IN

Permanent stalls w/ doors, wood with metal frame construction, 10 X10, \$75 per stall (Saturday night through Sunday at the end of the competition). **PLUS A SEPARATE STALL CLEANING DEPOSIT CHECK FOR \$25** (The \$25 check will NOT be deposited if stall is left stripped per Jim Brandon rules). Initial bedding not provided, but may be pre-purchased for \$7.00 per bag. **ABSOLUTELY NO HORSES will be accepted for stabling OR schooling until 12noon the day before the competition begins-early arrivals will be subject to a \$100 penalty per horse--Move in /schooling hours on Friday are from 12pm- 5:30pm and restricted to competition hours ONLY on show days.** Haul-in/Walk-in fee is \$50 per day if not stabling. Initial bedding not provided, but may be pre-purchased for \$7.00 per bag (& all bedding is the responsibility of the rider, including acts of God/weather issues).

Three to Four 20 x 60 m sand arenas with ample warm up in same footing.

Located at the **Palm Beach County Equestrian Center at 7500 Forest Hill Blvd, West Palm Beach, FL.** From the Florida Turnpike, Exit #93, Lake Worth Blvd., go west to HWY 441/SR 7, turn right/head north to Forest Hill Blvd; turn right /east, go approximately 1 1/2 mile & turn right into Equestrian Park Entrance. Follow posted signs for show office and barns. From the North—Okeechobee exit on Florida Turnpike #99, go west/right to HWY 441, turn left/south; go 3 miles to Forest Hill Blvd, turn left/east, go approximately 1 1/2 mile & turn right into Equestrian Park Entrance. Follow posted signs for show office and barns.
