**Musical Freestyles: Adequate sound system provided. Music on CD or cassette only, must be delivered to the announcer at least 3 hours before the start of the class. Mail test sheet from the highest test, 60% or higher in a USEF show with your entry.

***Team Competition - 4 Members per Team; no more than one Professional per team: one designated class per Team Member; rides must be designated on entry; one ride per Member. Team Member Fee \$10. Freestyles and Pas de Deux CANNOT be used for Team Competition. Team Mounted Awards Ceremony on Sunday during the Lunch Break, riders are to be properly attired and mounted.

***IDEAL School Lead Line Class: Child Rider's horse/pony led by an adult at a walk both ways of arena, halt, stand quietly. Judged on rider's ability to handle and aid horse/pony. Riders must wear approved riding helmet as well as boots. Festive attire or costumes are encouraged.

4. TIMES

ALL RIDE TIMES ARE TO BE CONSIDERED TENTATIVE (Check online at www.wellingtonclassicdressage.com or www.dressagedaily.com). Times will be posted the day before the show at the show grounds and mailed or e-mailed to your contact information about 1 week before the show & also available on show's website. Times are tentative and it is the rider's responsibility to know their final ride times, as times may change from the preliminary schedule. **Consult posted times each day on grounds for up-to-date-times!!!** **EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH" (GR1401.9)

5. STABLING & WALK-IN

Permanent stalls w/ doors, wood with metal frame construction, 10 X10, \$150 per stall (Friday night through Sunday at the end of the competition). **PLUS A SEPARATE STALL CLEANING DEPOSIT CHECK FOR \$25** (The \$25 check will NOT be deposited if stall is left stripped per Jim Brandon rules).

ABSOLUTELY NO HORSES will be accepted for stabling OR schooling until 12noon the day before the competition begins-early arrivals will be subject to a \$50 penalty per horse--Move in /schooling hours Friday are from 12pm-5:30pm on ship in day OR for competition hours ONLY. Haul-in/Walk-in fee is \$50 per day if not stabling. Initial bedding not provided, but may be pre-purchased for \$7.00 per bag (& all bedding is the responsibility of the rider, including acts of God/weather issues).

Follow posted signs for show office and barns. From the North—Okeechobee exit on Florida Turnpike #99, go west/right to HWY 441, turn left/south; go 3 miles to Forest Hill Blvd, turn left/east, go approximately 1 1/2 mile & turn right into Equestrian Park Entrance. Follow posted signs for show office and barns.
