***For Scores to count towards qualifying for Great American/USDF Regional Championships, add \$10.00 USDF fee to class fee and place a "Q" Behind the class name on your entry form(USEF Qual)** (Test of Choice classes may NOT be used for qualifying on the day that the Open class is offered).

***Musical Freestyles:** Adequate sound system provided. Music on CD or cassette only, must be delivered to the announcer at least 3 hours before the start of the class. Mail test sheet from the highest test, 60% or higher in a USEF show with your entry.

FEIX^: Class to be judged by a panel of 3 judges in an FEI format with 2 FEI Judges, 1 US Judge.

***** Opportunity Classes:** Riders/Horses competing only in "opportunity" classes are exempt from USEF/USDF membership requirements and do not have to pay NM, HID or USEF drug fees. In addition, owners, trainers & coaches are exempt from membership requirements for these classes. While membership requirements are waived for riders in "opportunity" classes, all USEF Dressage Division rules apply (including dress & saddlery requirements), in addition to all applicable General Rules such as Drugs & Medications. "Opportunity" riders & horses may cross enter into non-opportunity classes, but if you do so, all USEF/USDF membership requirements & fees will apply. Scores earned in "opportunity" classes may not be used toward USEF/USDF awards or programs.

2. AWARDS

Ribbons for six places. Trophy for first place. All prize Money Paid to Owner of Horse.

3. ENTRIES (class fees are per class)

Introductory,Opportunity/Materiale **\$45**; Training - Fourth **\$65**; FEI **\$85**; GAIG/USDF Qualifying: **\$10***; Office Fee (horse/rider) **\$45**; Drug/USEF Fee per horse **\$16**;USEF Non Member Fee **\$30**, USDF Non Member Fee **\$25**. Any changes of time or rider within a class-per change **\$25**; Late Entry fee - accepted at management's discretion - plus regular class fee per entry **\$50**; Non Competing horse (schooling) per horse **\$50**; ; Faxed Entry Fee **\$10**; Credit Card Service Fee **\$15**; Program notation - horse(s) for sale **\$35**.Returned Check/Declined Card Fee **\$50+** bank fee. Equine Nanny Services **\$10** per horse per night. **Haul-in/Walk-in fee is \$50 per day if not stabling, or boarding on the grounds.**

NOTE: Management shall regard as official data only those complete entries made via postmarked/overnight /registered mail or via on-line entry system if offered, which are received by closing date or until schedule is full,

whichever is sooner. Any incomplete entries or information sent directly to management by e-mail or fax is not a guaranteed entry. Management reserves the right to split, cancel, or change the day of classes to balance unusual amounts of entries, excessive scratches or due to extenuating circumstances, and to refuse an entry for a cause. All riders/owners/handlers must restrict horse use to WCD leased arenas, warm-ups and barn areas as designated ONLY. *Credit Cards Welcome: Visa, Mastercard, AMEX-must include name, billing address, card number, expiration date and 3 or 4 digit security code(on back of card) on entry form. Credit Card Service Fee \$15. NO REFUNDS, INCLUDING STABLING, FOR ANY REASON AFTER THE CLOSING DATE; including USEF art. GR311.

4. TIMES ALL RIDE TIMES ARE TO BE CONSIDERED TENTATIVE (www.wellingtonclassicdressage.com)

Times will be posted the day before the show at the show grounds and emailed to the rider about 1 week before the show & also available on WCD website. **Times are tentative and it is the rider's responsibility to know their final ride times, as times may change from preliminary schedule!!!**

5. STABLING & WALK-IN

Permanent stalls w/ doors, wood with metal frame construction, 10 X10, \$95 per stall (Friday night through Sunday at the end of the competition). **PLUS A SEPARATE STALL CLEANING DEPOSIT CHECK FOR \$25** (The \$25 check will NOT be deposited if stall is left stripped). **Initial bedding not provided, but may be pre-purchased for \$8.00 per bag. ABSOLUTELY NO HORSES will be accepted for stabling OR schooling until 12noon the day before the competition begins-early arrivals will be subject to a \$50 penalty per horse--Move in /schooling hours on Friday are from 12pm- 5:30pm and restricted to competition hours ONLY on show days.** Haul-in/Walk-in fee is \$50 per day if not stabling. Initial bedding not provided, but may be pre-purchased for \$8.00 per bag (& all bedding is the responsibility of the rider, including acts of God/weather issues).

Turn Right(West) onto Lake Worth Road and proceed west until the road ends (about 5 miles). Make a right onto South Shore Boulevard. Continue past Pierson Road. The entrance to the showgrounds is the next right after Pierson. Main Entrance is clearly marked. Follow posted signs for show office and barns.
